**Call to Order**

**I. Welcome and Introductions**

Rhonda called the meeting to order at 8:28 a.m. and welcomed everyone. Those present introduced themselves.

**II. Approve minutes from April 6, 2017**

The April 6, 2017, DAC minutes were read and approved.

It was motioned, second and passed (MSP) by Nancy Davis and Elizabeth Lozano (Davis, Lozano) to accept the April 6, 2017, minutes. (7-0)

**III. LCAP Update -(CR)**

- LCAP was shared goal-by-goal, action-by-action with additional time for suggestions and feedback.
- Rhonda Garfield asked how parent engagement is going. Nancy, Bill, and Courtney shared some of the activities they have done to further engage parents at each of their school sites.
- Liz gave a brief overview of the Multi-Tiered System of Behavior Support, and how the District is reviewing what systems are currently in place. Liz shared that there needs to be a clear understanding district-wide, as to what is available and implemented at each tier on a Multi-Tier System. The focus next year will be the Behavioral Social-emotional component of the Multi-Tier System.

#### **IV. Special Education Report for 2016-2017 –(SC)**

- Scott gave a brief description of the tests that school Psychologists performs. He then reviewed, by site, the number of each test that has been performed throughout the year. It was shared that these numbers only reflect the students on an IEP, in addition to servicing these students the Psychologist provide counseling groups and individual counseling services to general education students.

#### **V. Technology Update -(MT)**

- Steve Tashima was filling in for Mark Tompkins. Steve informed us that we have 1-1 iPads for all students. He also mentioned that 400 iPads are being replaced, due to age this summer.

#### **VII. Questions or Concerns**

Danny Llamas addressed his concerns about 8<sup>th</sup> graders transitioning to High School, and knowing which classes they should be taking to prepare for college. Some ideas were shared and the committee was informed that Akers has done a college evening for the past several years and it has evolved into a very nice parent-student information night. It was suggested that this was something that could be developed at Central and Stratford. Since Mrs. Gonzales will be working on the Central campus next year, it was suggested she along with the District counselor, could look into developing a plan to provide an information night for students and parents at Central. Mrs. Lozano stated that the District would be supportive of that, and would like to see if Stratford could also participate. Mr. Llamas stated he would be more than happy to assist.
