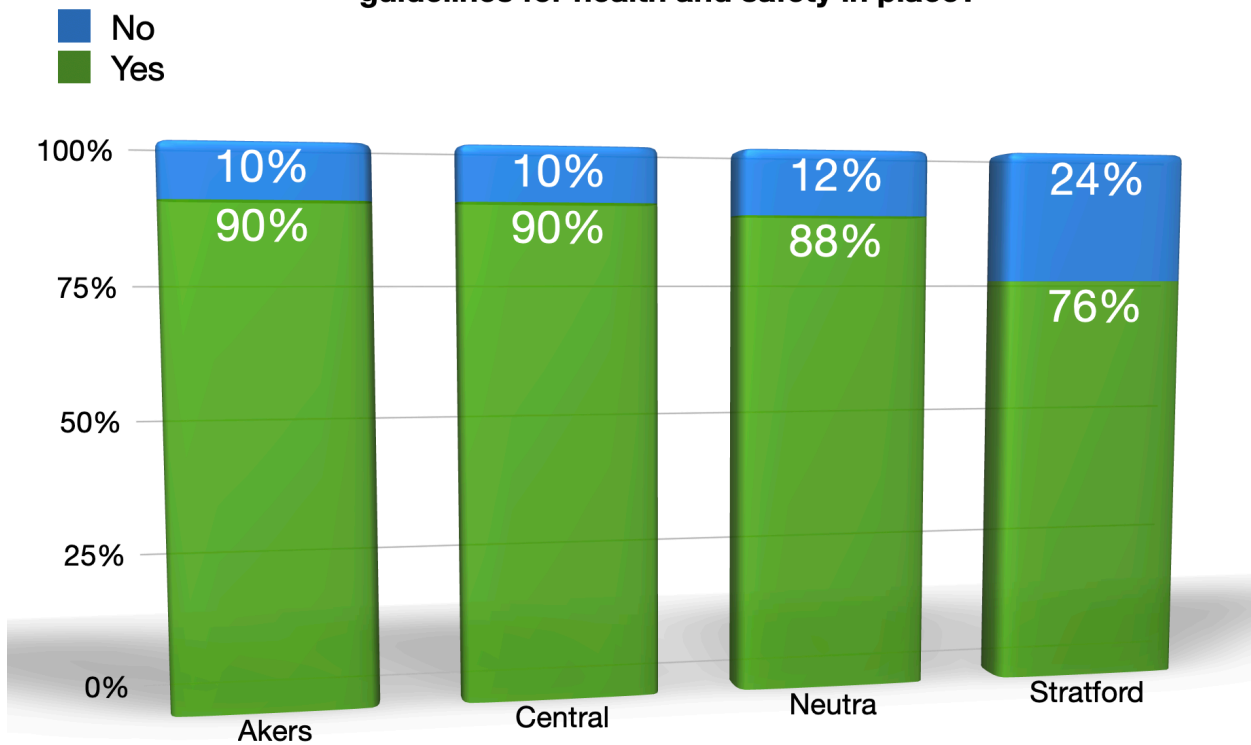


Dear Families and Community,
